

**CCFS Operating By-Law Amendments, Effective: January 1, 2022**

**The following amendments have been made to the Operating By-Laws of Catholic Cemeteries & Funeral Services, with a revision and printing date of September 2017.**

**AMENDMENT 1: Page 9, A definition for Quintuple Lot has been added:**

QUINTUPLE LOT – a five grave lot permitting an upright monument and which may contain a maximum of ten interments or, where noted by the Owner on the Interment Rights Certificate, a maximum of five interments.

**AMENDMENT 2: Page 10, 3 I CARE AND MAINTENANCE FUND**

The Owner shall deposit into the Care and Maintenance Fund the following amounts as prescribed in the Act:

**(a) Interment Rights**

For a grave larger than 2.23 square metres, the greater of 40 percent of the purchase price or \$290.00.

For a grave smaller than 2.23 square metres, the greater of 40 percent of the purchase price or \$175.00.

For crypts, the greater of 20 percent of the purchase price or \$830.00.

For niches, the greater of 15 percent of the purchase price or \$165.00.

**(b) Marker Installation**

Flat marker over 1,116 square centimetres, \$100.00.

Upright monument up to 1.22 metres in height or width, \$200.00.

Upright monument over 1.22 metres in height or width, \$400.00.

**AMENDMENT 3: Page 19; section 6III (b)**

(b) Single, Double, Triple, Quadruple and Quintuple Monument Lots: Restricted to 34 inches in height, 35 1/2 inches in width and 92 inches in length.

**AMENDMENT 4: Add to page 31 Section 10 IV in item (i):**

**TO:**

(i) Any monument exceeding 3 feet 6 inches and up to 5 feet in height, including base, must be 10 inches in thickness. Any monument exceeding 5 feet in height, including base, must be 12 inches in thickness.

**AMENDMENT 5: Page 31 Section 10 IV (j) Maximum size of dies and bases for Quintuple Lots:**

**DIE**

8 feet 0 inches in length

4 feet 10 inches in height

**BASE**

8 feet 6 inches in length

1 foot 6 inches in width

**OVERALL**

5 feet 10 inches in height

**AMENDMENT 6:**

The word "photoplaque" has been deleted throughout the bylaws The word "photoplaque" appeared 12 times.
